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СПОСОБЫ ОРГАНИЗАЦИИ ОБРАЗОВАТЕЛЬНОЙ ДЕЯТЕЛЬНОСТИ ПРИ ОНЛАЙН ОБУЧЕНИИ

Teleconference - are usually held on the basis of mailing lists with using email. Educational teleconferencing is characterized by the achievement educational tasks.
